Items for Discussion:

Introduction to Auto

Mr. Dague presented proposed a .5 credit, one semester Introduction to Auto course. This course would fill a need for an automotive course that is not at the vocational level and would provide students with an overview of vehicle systems, teach some basic car maintenance, and discuss basic financial impacts of car ownership. This course would attract students who are interested in cars, but do not want all of the information and practice provided in Auto I. It would not eliminate students from taking Auto I and Auto II, but instead could be a good way for students to gauge their interest for these courses. This course would be open to students in Grades 9-12. Additional staff would not be needed. No books are needed; free online resources can be used.

Committee members approved this course addition.

Data Presentation

Ms. Middleton presented a short presentation as a part of the ongoing data conversations conducted in subcommittee meetings. Committee members requested some changes to the format of the presentation and for clarification of the information gained from each assessment. Ms. Middleton discussed the interventions and next steps being taken as a result of the data analysis being conducted by the Academic Office.
