Technology Education Course Change Proposals – John Dague

- i. Supplant Computer Architectural course 712 with Civil Engineering and Architectural course 792;
- ii. Supplant Computer Drafting Mechanical course 713 with -Intro to Engineering Design course 790;
- iii. Metals Technology course 721, offered at EHS only, should be moved in POS to inactive as the new school will not have the space/technology available during renovation and after. The course would be supplanted with the Materials Processing course 761 taught at Fermi. **Supplanted courses would appear in the addendum as INACTIVE**

Carl Perkins Innovation Grant (\$36,000-materials and professional training) provided funds for training for John Dague on the new CNC laser. John will train Tech Ed department staff.
