Standards-Based Grading: Frequently-Asked Questions

1. What is the expected timeline for student mastery of the standards?

All standards reflect end-of-year grade-level expectations. Students work to develop the skills and concepts identified in each standard with the goal of mastery by year's end.

2. What does each indicator represent?

Each indicator represents the grade-level skills and concepts specific to each subject's state standards.

3. Will my child receive one overall grade in each subject area?

With standards-based grading, students do not receive one final grade for each subject. Instead, each indicator is individually assessed.

4. How are indicator scores determined by teachers?

Throughout the trimester, teachers collect a variety of evidence on each standard being taught and use the most recent student progress data to determine indicator scores for students.
